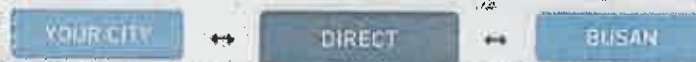


# Getting Here

## Transportation between the Gimhae (Busan) Airport and the official hotels

Gimhae International Airport is the closest airport to Busan and is situated approximately 27km from the official hotels. There are four different means of transportation from Gimhae Airport to the hotels: limousine bus, city bus, subway and taxi. It is recommended that delegates take either the airport limousine bus or taxi to get to the hotels. All delegates will need to arrange their own transport between the airport and the hotels.

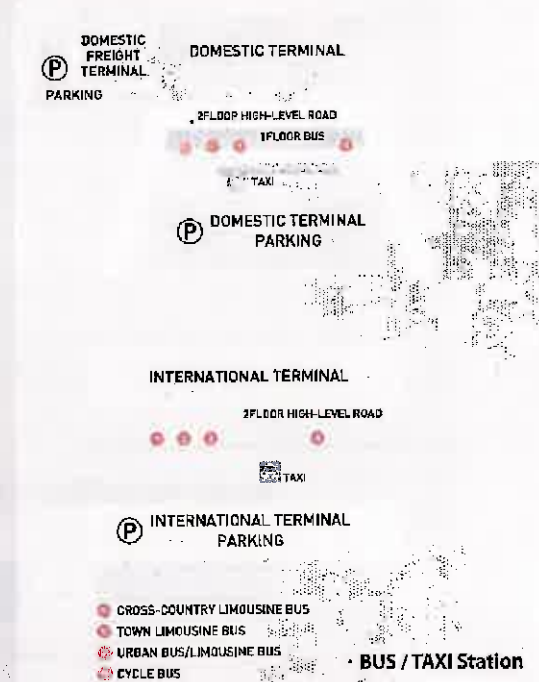

If you exit through Gate 3 and cross the zebra stripes, you will be at the taxi stand.

Delegates can take a taxi to all parts of Busan. You will be charged approximately KRW 25,000-30,000 for a 60min journey from the Airport to the Paradise hotel.



## Subway

If you exit through Gate 3, cross, take a right and walk for 30 meters you will be at the Light Rail 'Airport Station'.

Take Busan Gimhae LRT from the Busan airport and change at Sasang Station to Subway Line 2

- **Westin Chosun Hotel** : Dongbaek Station exit no.1

## Transportation between Incheon Airport (Seoul) and Busan

You can choose between taking the train or airplane to travel between Incheon Airport and Busan.

### ① Train : Incheon Airport to Busan station by KTX(Korea Train Express)

☛ recommended:

Taking the KTX is the most convenient way to travel from Incheon Airport to Busan Station. The trip takes approximately 3 hours and 50 minutes. You can take a KTX at Incheon airport station (1st basement floor of Incheon Airport) to Busan station.

If you cannot take the direct KTX from Incheon Airport to Busan, first take the Airport Express to Seoul station, then take the KTX from Seoul station to Busan station. Please make sure to check the train schedule in advance.



### ② Airplane : Incheon Airport to Gimhae Airport by Airplane

Seoul has two airports, Incheon Airport (for international flights) and Gimpo airport (for domestic flights). Delegates can travel from Incheon Airport to Busan by airplane.

You can take an airplane from Incheon Airport or Gimpo airport to Gimhae airport (the nearest airport from Busan). There are 3-4 flights a day for transfer passengers from Incheon airport and more than 20 domestic flights a day from Gimpo airport to Gimhae airport. Airport express trains connect Incheon Airport and Gimpo Airport every 5-10 minutes and take approximately 20-30 minutes.

## ITINERARY

Hotel – Beomeosa Temple – Gamcheon Cultural Village – BIFF Square  
– Gukje Market – Jagalchi Market – Hotel

### ▶ Beomeosa Temple

Located on the lower slopes of Geumjeongsan Mountain, Beomeosa Temple has a long history as it was built over 1,300 years ago by Eusang Daesa, a Buddhist Master, during the reign of King Munmu of the Shilla Dynasty. Those who want to escape from their busy lives can do just that at HyuhyuJeongsa of Beomeosa Temple, which offers a “temple stay” program.

### ▶ Gamcheon Cultural Village

This village, where houses ascend up the mountainside like a staircase and alleyways crisscross along the area's gentle slopes, creates a distinctive landscape that cannot be found anywhere else.

The village itself is a piece of art and popular tourist attraction thanks to the formative artwork built throughout its narrow paths by resident artists.

### ▶ BIFF Square

BIFF Square confirms Busan as a city of cinema. The cinemas of Nampodong are located in this plaza, where you can enjoy movies, shopping and entertainment. A circular stage and the hand prints of the world-renowned movie celebrities set into the pavement of the plaza are reminders of the fact that this was the main venue of the Busan International Film Festival.

### ▶ Gukje Market

This is the most important traditional market in Busan. It opened shortly after the country's liberation from Japan, and became fully established following the Korean War. After entering the city at Busan Port, various imported goods are distributed and sold through this market to the rest of the country. Due to its location adjoining other retail districts such as Kkangtong Market, Changsun Shopping Mall, and Manmulei Street, which literally means “street selling everything,” this area is always full of life.

### ▶ Jagalchi Market

In the Jagalchi Market you will hear the familiar sound of merchants shouting “Oiso, boiso, saiso!” which means “Come, look and buy!” in the local Busan dialect. Jagalchi is also full of the warmth and kindness that is typically found among the residents of Busan. As the largest fish market in the Southeast region, Jagalchi Market sells a full range of marine products including fresh catches of fish and quality dried fish at excellent prices.

### ▶ Shinsegae Shopping Center & Mall

The Shopping Center and Mall is connected to the underground passageway of Centum metro Station. Shinsegae Department Store is registered in the Guinness Book as the largest department store in the world. Lotte Department Store is also located in this Center. It is a composite shopping and cultural space full of attractions enjoyable all year round such as clothing shops, food shops, indoor ice rinks, spa land and theaters.



# General Information

## Overview of Korea

Korea is a peninsula located on the northeastern edge of the Asian continent, and bordered by China and Russia. The Republic of Korea occupies about 100,000km<sup>2</sup> of the peninsula south of the 38th parallel, bordering the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

## Overview of Busan

Busan is the second largest city in the Republic of Korea. It exemplifies how natural beauty and modern life can coexist in perfect harmony. From serene, thousand-year-old temple site to the tallest residential skyscrapers in Asia, Busan fuses the elements of what the world was in centuries past and where it's headed into the near and distant future.

It is also the nation's largest port city, located at the southeastern tip of the Korean peninsula. Japan sits just east of Busan and China to the west, offering convenient proximity to all Northeast Asia.

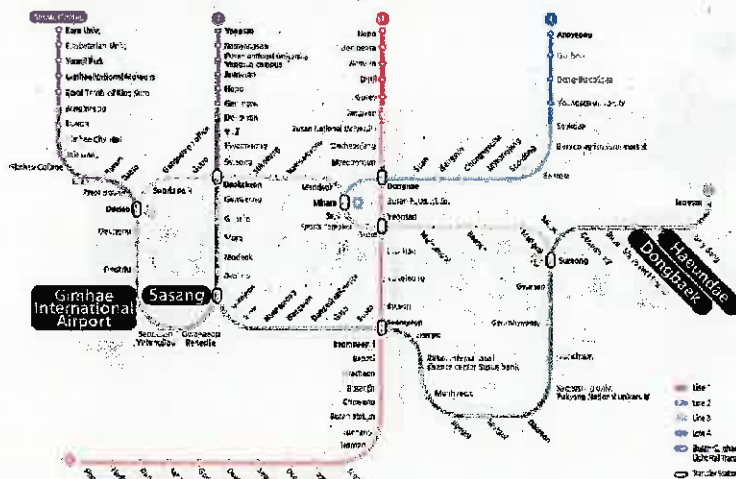
## Transportation

Extensive road, rail, and air networks put everything within easy reach.

### ► SUBWAY

The Busan subway system is the fastest, most convenient way to travel around the city. The metro's four lines, as well as the Busan-Gimhae Light Rail (which takes you directly to Gimhae International Airport), put the whole city within reach. For the convenience of visitors, announcements are made in English, Japanese, Chinese, and Korean.

▶ **BUS**

A bus fare can be paid by cash or by transportation card (used to pay both bus and Metro fares) upon boarding a bus. To indicate you want to get off, push the button on the wall. Get off through the back door.

▶ **TAXI**

The basic fare is 2,800 won per 2km and then extra charges are added depending on the distance and time covered. From midnight, a late hour premium will also be charged.

### Currency

Korea's official monetary unit is the Won. Foreign currencies may be exchanged at most banks or authorized money exchanges.



### Credit Cards

Visa, Master Card, American Express, Diners Club, and other major credit cards are accepted at most tourist hotels, department stores, restaurants, etc. Some smaller stores may not accept credit cards, so make sure to have some cash in your wallet. Depending on your bank or credit card, you may be able to withdraw money from an ATM in Korea.



### Phones & Internet

Although somewhat hard to find, public phones in Korea are easy to use and take phone cards, coins or credit cards. If you want to rent a cellular phone, you can use KT, SK and LG which are Korea's major phone service providers, and they have booth at Incheon Airport, where phone can be rented. For smart phone users, Korea has many free Wi-Fi hot spots.

### Electricity supply

The power supply in Korea is 220v, 60Hz. A step-down transformer is needed to cover the current to 110-120v. Delegates need to bring their own electronic adaptors.

For those who wish to take a day off, we recommend the following tourist sites.

### Tour type 1.

Time : 4 hours

Itinerary : BEXCO – Dalmaji-gil Road – Haedong Yonggungsa Temple

### Dalmaji-gil Road

Dalmaji-gil Road is a small walkway that curves its way to Songjeong Beach. The road boasts beautiful cherry blossoms and pine trees, which are located just beyond Haeundae Beach, on the slopes of Mt. Wausan. The landscape, with its blue sea and sandy seashores, is famous for its beauty and is sure to be a favorite among tourists and locals alike for a long time to come. Roughly eight kilometers of roadway stretch along the Dalmaji Hill and at its peak is a clock tower, representing the marine city of Busan as it stretches up to the sky and reaches out to the world.

### Haedong Yonggungsa Temple

This temple, which looks as if it were rising out of the deep blue sea, continues to attract visitors because of the legend that says this place will grant wishes to those who pray. Images of the Chinese zodiac signs and sexagenarian cycle are also enshrined here. In an effort to spread peace and well-being, a tower wishing for traffic safety has been installed at this temple.

### Beomeosa Temple Life

Located on the lower slopes of Geumjeongsan Mountain, Beomeosa Temple has a long history as it was built over 1,300 years ago by Eusang Daesa, a Buddhist Master, during the reign of King Munmu of the Shilla Dynasty.

Those who want to escape from their busy lives can do just that at HyuhyuJeongsa of Beomeosa Temple, which offers a "temple stay" program.

The program includes experiencing Zen meditation, the 108 bows, tea ceremonies and Buddhist martial arts. Time spent at the temple allows visitors to forget their mundane worries and the stress of daily life.



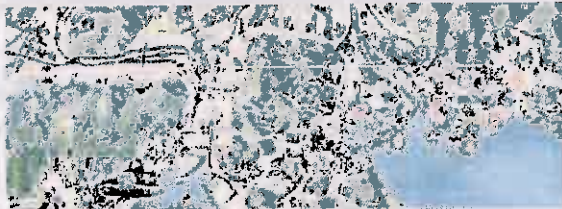
